



# Pig Locks & Pig Retainers

FES PIG LOCKS (or PIG RETAINERS) are installed to the outside of subsea pipework and protrude into the bore.

The central pig prevents the pigs from moving during installation or decommissioning. PIG RETAINERS are also able to prevent accidental pig firing on FES PIG LAUNCHERS and RECEIVERS.

- Designed in accordance with API17D, API 6A, API RP2A, ASME VIII div II, ASME B31.3, ASME B31.8, ISO13628-4, ISO 10423, PD5500, and PED. Other specifications are available on request.
